Seminar Classes:

Foundation Sequencing 8/14, 8:00-11:30

This session will focus on sequencing tailored towards young up-and-coming teams. We will work on balancing / transitioning between forward focus elements to more handler focused skills. We will introduce our young dogs to layering, to build trust in driving lines and couple this with timely execution of side changes and other skills. We'll be using jumps and tunnels only with focus on communication and flow. Dogs should be sequencing 5-10 obstacles. Young – Novice Dogs.

Fronts, Blinds and Rears, On My! 8/14, 12:30-4:00

Perfect your side changes by knowing WHEN, HOW and WHERE you should use a front, blind or rear cross. Sequences will be used to demonstrate which options provide the most clarity for your dog to give the fastest line through the course. Teams will have the opportunity to try different options on the same sequence. Our focus will be on perfecting your mechanics, position and timing. Dogs should be capable of sequencing 5- 10 jumps, tunnels and 12 weaves. Intermediate - Advance.

International Coursework 8/15, 8-11:30

Full course work focusing on distance and layering to build confidence and speed on a large open style course. Learn how to train and handle the skills needed to create fast, flowing lines even when faced with tough challenges! Master – International

Discrimination Master Class 8/15, 12:30-4:00

Full course work focusing on extension/collection and ins/outs to avoid potential off courses. Learn to use verbal cues that support your body language when confronted with choices seen by your dog. Clear and timely information is essential for success. Master - International.
